Waste Mangement of NY proposes renewal of the existing solid waste management permit for the operation of a solid waste transfer station that is authorized to accept putrescible solid waste (PSW), source separated organic waste (SSOW), construction and demolition debris (C&D), sewage grit and screenings (SGS), and yard waste (YW); and modification of its operations, to be implemented in two phases, to add liquid organic waste (LOW) and the processing of Engineered Food Waste (EFW).

The facility may receive no more than 3540 tons per day (TPD) of PSW (up to 900 TPD of which may be substituted for C&D, on a ton-for-ton basis), 500 TPD of SSOW, 210 TPD of LOW, 30 TPD of SGS, and 30 TPD of YW.

The maximum amount of solid waste on-site at any one time must not exceed 8,230 cubic yards (CY). Of these wastes 6,150 CY comprises PSW; including up to 1,200 CY of C&D, 30 CY of SGS and 120 CY of YW, 560 CY of SSOW on the facility floor, 1,285 CY (equivalent to 260,000 gallons) of EFW, and 235 CY (equivalent to 48,000 gallons) of LOW.

Operating hours are proposed for 24 hours a day, Monday through Saturday; closed Sunday.

The facility is located at in the Williamsburg Industrial Park section of Brooklyn. The property is approximately 4.6 acres in size and is located on the English Kills. A document repository has been established at Brooklyn Community Board 1, 435 Graham Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11211
