# WASTE MANAGEMENT, CHILDREN'S MUSEUM OF PHOENIX, ABCO RECYCLING TEAM UP FOR EARTH DAY EDUCATION

**Phoenix, AZ, April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2010** - Education is vital as communities throughout the Valley of the Sun work towards becoming more sustainable. That's why the Children's Museum of Phoenix, Waste Management, and ABCO Recycling and Shredding Services have teamed up to host a **free "Shred-A-Thon" on Earth Day, Thursday, April 22nd.** The event will be held from 9am-3pm in the north parking lot of the Children's Museum of Phoenix, located at 215 N. 7<sup>th</sup> Street, on the SE corner of 7<sup>th</sup> Street and Van Buren.

"As a children's museum we have a tremendous opportunity and an incredible obligation to positively inform and shape the future of our community," said **Deb Gilpin**, President and CEO of the Children's Museum of Phoenix. "This Shred-a-Thon will do just that by helping families learn about things that they can do to become more sustainable."

"Many people forget that shredded paper is recyclable," said ABCO Recycling President **Nick D'Andrea.** "We hope this event will remind the community that while it is important to shred your old documents for protection, it's also important to dispose of that shredded material properly."

Families dropping off items for shredding will receive \$2 off regular Museum admission of \$9. The discount offer is valid for the day of the Shred-A-Thon only (April 22<sup>nd</sup>). Participants will receive a receipt from ABCO Recycling which they can then use to receive the Museum discount. The discount is valid for each family member, including all caregivers and their children. All adults must be accompanied by a child to gain access into the Museum.

April is **Earth & Sky Month** at the Museum, sponsored by Waste Management. The Museum's Earth & Sky Month programming focuses on helping the environment by living green. Programming includes environmental education on recycling and the planet we live on with fun, hands-on projects.
