Waste Management Obtains LEED® Certification at Transfer Station

Ceremony Marks the First Gold-level Certification for a Waste Facility in Arizona

Tucson, AZ – September 17th, 2009 – Waste Management of Arizona will be joined by representatives from the U.S. Green Building Council, Stantec Consulting, and Caylor Construction to celebrate the LEED® certification awarded to WM's Rincon Recycling & Transfer Station facility. Waste Management received the prestigious certification after completing a series of remodeling projects to meet LEED for New Construction guidelines. The administration building, scale house, and site all received gold-level recognition. A plaque-hanging ceremony will take place on Tuesday, September 22nd.

"We are committed to being good stewards of the environment," said Waste Management Area Vice President Dan Vermeer. "This certification is a symbol of our continuous efforts to make our communities more sustainable."

Caylor Construction was the general contractor for the project and Stantec was the LEED consulting firm. Both companies worked closely with Waste Management engineers to gather the necessary points to obtain the certification.

Tricia Cook, Project Manager for Stantec, said, "It takes a team of experienced, dedicated professionals who understand and believe in the principles of sustainable design to bring a project like this to a successful completion. The certification demonstrates the effort put into this facility by everyone involved."
