Drop-Off Recycling Programs

WM's Lancaster Landfill and Recycling Center encourages unincorporated Los Angeles County area residents to take advantage of the following drop-off recycling programs for **FREE** during normal business hours.

Please bring proof of residency, such as a valid driver's license or billing statement with current address.

- One (1) bulky item per year (sofa, washer, water heater, etc.) 
- Tires—up to four (4) waste tires per year (no commercial tires accepted) 
- Free Residential Disposal Day in April and October 2023
- Mattress Recycling Program — residents can bring up to six (6) mattresses for free, mixed trash or recyclables cannot be accepted in the load. 
- TV's and computer monitors are accepted for free.
