What's New at the Lancaster Landfill?

How much do you weigh?

Recently, two new scales were installed at the Lancaster Landfill to facilitate a key component of the daily landfill operating system.



When a customer arrives, the vehicle drives on a scale and the computer system tracks the weight of the load to determine the rate for a customer to pay according to the fee schedule.

The need to accurately record weight ticketing and tracking is necessary to comply with government regulation and reporting requirements.

Did you Know? An empty trash truck weighs 36,000 lbs.
