# **Holiday Season Recycling Tips**

#### **Holiday Tree Recycling**

Holiday trees can be disposed of in two easy ways, but please remember: trees must be free of any decorations, including lights and flocking.

#### **Cut and place in Green Waste Cart**

Holiday trees can be cut into three foot sections and placed in your green waste cart. Please make sure the lid on the cart can close!



#### **Place Trees in Designated WM Bins**
