Through the use of its vermicomposting bin, the Resort is able to eliminate more than 300 pounds a month of food waste from ending up in a landfill. In addition to food waste, 7,000 gallons of used cooking oil and grease was collected and processed into biodiesel fuel in the last year.

"LEGOLAND California's sustainable practices go far beyond recycling," said Lori Somers municipal affairs representative for Waste Management in North County. "Their robust source reduction and closed-loop programs make them one of the most eco-friendly businesses in Carlsbad and we are thrilled to be supporting their efforts bringing them closer to achieve their zero waste goals."
