

Waste City of Oceanside: Solid Waste and Recycling Service Review Form



This Form is required for all service inquiries

The City of Oceanside is committed to waste diversion and recycling. The City of Oceanside's Municipal Code Chapter 13 requires all Oceanside residents, apartment complexes, and businesses to separate all designated recyclable materials from other solid waste. Additionally, California Assembly Bill 341- (Mandatory Commercial Recycling) mandates businesses that generate four cubic yards or more of solid waste weekly and multifamily complexes with 5 units or more to recycle.

City of Oceanside staff are available to help your business get on the road to zero waste and comply with City and State mandated recycling laws. Once the form has been received, City of Oceanside Staff will respond to your inquiry within 10 days.

Operate efficiently while strengthening your bottom line, we can right size your services to meet all of your recycling needs!

<u>Minimum Service Levels</u>: One unit of commercial cart service is required for each water meter registered to a commercial business. Multifamily complexes are required two commercial cart services for every 4 units. Complexes with 9 or more units require dumpster service. Service levels must be adequate for amount of waste being generated on site. It is the responsibility of the business to notify Waste Management of missing or broken carts and locks.

<u>Dumpster service</u> is available in 3 yard and 4 yard bins for both landfill and recycling with service up to six days per week. City Code Chapter 13 further addresses trash enclosure requirements.

<u>Split bin service</u> is for businesses with limited space for landfill and recycling service. This bin is a standard 3 yard dumpster, that is split down the middle to accommodate landfill on one side and recycling on the other.

<u>Commercial cart service</u> is reserved for multifamily complexes with 8 or less units and/or small businesses per City approval. One unit of commercial cart service includes one 96-gallon landfill cart and on 96-gallon recycling cart serviced one time per week.
