Compressed Natural Gas (CNG)

CNG is a clean burning fuel that is better for the environment than traditional petroleum based gasoline.

CNG Vehicles

CNG powered vehicles produce almost half of the emissions that federal guidelines allow, making Waste Management's hauling vehicles among the cleanest fleets of heavy-duty trucks in the United States. Waste Management of Orange County operates 54 CNG trucks.

Operating the Orange County fleet of clean burning trucks is equivalent to taking over 4,000 vehicles off the road each day!
