GREEN WASTE STREET PILE RULES REMINDER



Green waste street piles are a convenient way to set out all those trimmings you collected while maintaining your property. However, piles cannot be properly collected, and our streets won't remain clean, if some basic set out rules are not followed.

Use Green Waste Cart As First Option

If possible, please place your yard trimmings in your green waste cart (brown lid) for collection. Placing trimmings in the cart helps keep city streets clean and ensures you are not setting out larger, unacceptable items for collection.

No Tree Stumps or Large Tree Branches

Tree stumps and branches larger than six inches in diameter and/or longer than three feet pose a safety hazard for our drivers and can cause damage to our equipment. If the material is too heavy or cannot fit in your green waste cart, it should not be placed in your green waste pile. If you plan to trim or remove a tree from your property, please contact a professional tree trimming company for proper disposal.

Seven Day Limit for Street Piles

Street piles cannot remain on the street for more than seven days. Please do not begin creating your street pile until at most seven days before collection. The City of Winters will strictly enforce this regulation and issue fines for homeowners who have street piles in front of or in the vicinity of their property for more than a week. This regulation is being strictly enforced to help maintain clean streets and allow for proper street cleaning.
