- **Dollar Dump Days (April 19)**

- Lodi Transfer Station (Gate 3) 1333 E. Turner Road from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

\$1 per car, truck or trailer load, not to exceed 2-cubic yards. Loads in excess of 2-cubic yards will be charged regular gate rates.

- NO commercial vehicles.
- Must be a resident of the City of Lodi. Proof of residency will be required.
- NO Universal Waste will be collected on this day. Please see April 12 Free E-Waste and Universal Waste event above.
- Tires, televisions, computers and monitors will be charged regular rates.
- Refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners must have a Freon removal certificate or these items will be charged regular rates.
- Motor oil will be accepted.

- **Earth Day - Free Clean Your Files Week (April 21-25)**

- Lodi Transfer Station (Gate 3) 1333 E. Turner Road from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

- Accepting: office paper (all color), carbonless paper, file folders, binding envelopes, fliers, catalogs and junk mail.
- Please remove paper clips, binder clips, rubber bands, metal and plastic.
- These items will not be shredded.

- **2014 Annual Residential Cleanup Week (April 28-May 2)**

- Beginning on Monday, April 28, Waste Management will begin the Annual Curbside Cleanup program for residents in the City of Lodi. Crews from Waste Management will collect items at the curb this week on the residents' regular service day. This one-time special service is provided at no charge to residential customers.

Applies to single-family homes, duplexes and triplexes in the City of Lodi.

- All items must be bagged, bundled, boxed or containerized and must weigh less than 50 pounds.
- Items to be disposed must be at the curb directly in front of your home and be away from parked cars and trash carts.
- Items should be at the curb no later than 5:00 a.m. on your regular service day.
- Please no hazardous materials or toxic waste, tires, televisions, computers and monitors (e-waste), rock, dirt, concrete, liquids, batteries, paint, pesticides, antifreeze, petroleum products or auto parts.
