FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. Can I use carts other than the carts provided by Waste Management?

A. No. The Unincorporated Washoe County residential franchise agreement requires the use of Waste Management carts.

Q. Should I set out my carts if they're not full?

A. Your trash cart should be set at the curb at 7 AM weekly. You may wait until your recycling cart is full before setting it out on your scheduled recycling collection day.

Q. Do I need to rinse out my recyclables prior to placing them in my recycling cart?

A. No. However, liquids or loose food cannot be placed in the recycling cart because they spoil the recyclability of paper and cardboard. If necessary, use a spatula to remove food from containers.

Q. What will happen if I use my recycling cart as a trash cart?

A. Contamination from just one resident can spoil an entire load of recyclables. Therefore, if you place trash in your recycling cart, you will receive up to two warnings. On the third and fourth offense, you will be billed for contamination. This charge will be added to the next bill. On the fifth offense, the recycling cart will be removed from your home.

Q. What if I have extra waste that won't fit into my trash cart?

A. Use one of the 25 Excess Waste Stickers mailed annually. Place it on a 32-gallon bag, box or bundle (not to exceed 3' x 3' x 3' or 50 pounds) and leave curbside with your trash cart. If bags or bundles do not have a sticker, they will not be collected. Call customer service at 775-329-8822, to add another cart or to purchase more stickers. Or visit the transfer stations or landfill to dispose of the waste.

Q. What happens if a cart is stolen or damaged?

A. Contact customer service at 775-329-8822 to replace or repair your cart.

Q. What should I do with my carts if I move?

A. Call customer service at 775-329-8822 to cancel service as you may be responsible for carts if they are lost or stolen.

Q. What do I do if I miss my pickup?

A. Call customer service at 775-329-8822 to schedule a special pickup for an additional charge. Or wait until your next service day and leave your extra bagged waste at the curb with an Excess Waste Sticker.

Q. Where can I pay my Waste Management bill?

- A. Managing your account is easy. There are four options to pay your bill: (1) Register your Waste Management account online and pay your bill through the EZ Pay system.
- (2) Mail in your payment.
- (3) Pay your bill in person at the Waste Management of Nevada office from Mon. - Fri., 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.. No cash accepted.
- (4) Contact the call center at 775-329-8822, Mon. Fri., 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

ACCESS TO THE TRANSFER STATION & LANDFILL

Washoe County residential customers may dispose of one standard pickup truck (not to exceed three cubic yards) of trash four times a year at no cost anytime during the transfer stations' and Lockwood Landfill's normal operating schedules. To use this service, customers must be current in their payments and must show a recent trash bill or have identification that matches the service address on their bill.

All trash and recyclables must be placed in Waste Management carts. Waste that does not fit in your cart may be placed in a 32-gallon bag, box or bundle (not to exceed 3' x 3' x 3' or 50 pounds) and must be marked with one of your 25 Excess Waste Stickers for pick up.

During the months of May and November, Unincorporated Washoe County customers can place an additional six bags, boxes or bundles (not to exceed 3' x 3' x 3' or 50 pounds) outside the container on the service day without using an Excess Waste Sticker.
