## Atascocita Landfill Spring 2026

### MANAGER'S REPORT

Hello, neighbors! I hope this new year is off to a great start for you and your family. This year will be one of meaningful progress as we continue invest in the long-term environmental health and efficiency of our facility.

We recently began Phase 1 of our 2026 landfill gas system upgrades. This work focuses on re-drilling and improving gas wells on the north hill to strengthen our ability to collect landfill gas and reduce greenhouse gas emissions. These upgrades help ensure we continue operating as responsible environmental stewards for our community and surrounding ecosystem.

Additionally, our team is actively shaping and preparing the north hill for its final grade, which represents a major milestone in the post-closure process for this area of the landfill. Our goal is to complete the northern tip of the north hill by the end of Q2, and everyone's hard work is moving us steadily toward that target.

Completing the final cap in this section of the landfill is an important part of the post-closure process required by our permit. This step brings several key benefits: by placing the final cap, we maintain a protective seal that prevents moisture and rain from penetrating the landfill waste, and we also enhance gas collection efficiency for our renewable natural gas plant.

We also understand how important a clean and orderly environment is for our neighbors. To support that commitment, we've added additional litter-control crews to help collect windblown debris and items that may be left behind along nearby roadways. This added effort helps ensure our operations remain a good neighbor to everyone who lives and travels in the area.
