

Eagle Valley says farewell to John Spokaeski, Jr.

John Spokaeski, Jr. retired as a heavy equipment operator at Eagle Valley Recycling and Disposal Facility after 36 years with Waste Management. John was a member of the Teamsters Union 247 and served as the Union Steward at Eagle Valley. His father also worked for Waste Management. John Spokaeski, Sr. was a district manager from 1984 to 2002 - a well-respected member of the Orion community. Eagle Valley is a small operation but employs other Spokaeski family members -Kelly Spokaeski, John's wife, runs our scale house, Rick Godlewski and Kenny Orzechowski are heavy equipment operators and John's nephews, and Jack Henry, heavy equipment mechanic, is John's brother-in-law, it is a close-knit group at Eagle Valley. Looking back at his 36 years, John shared some of his fondest memories - school bus tours for local students, WM hosted parties for Seniors in the community, and working with his father at SCAMP Picnics, every July hosting the picnic for children with disabilities, which included grilling 600 to 700 hot dogs.

2021 Site Activities at Eagle Valley

Seeding will begin on the north, west and south slopes of the landfill in the spring. We will be seeding with a mix of native wildflowers with grass seed on the north and south slopes.

The road that exists between old Cell 1 and western cell development will be removed with waste filling operations taking place in the "valley" area in preparation for an overlay liner installation in the fall or early in 2022.

Landfill gas work will not be scheduled until sometime later in the year.
