Site Activities

We are currently filling the upper east and southwest slopes of the landfill. You may also notice some new activity in the area of our property at Giddings and Silver Bell Rd. This year, WM

installed a device that is utilized to remove hydrogen sulfide (H2S) from the landfill gas. We are also constructing a concrete pad in this area. The pad is for a 500,000 gallon leachate collection tank. Leachate is the liquid that is released by waste as it decomposes, along with precipitation that filters through the waste.

Good News for SE Michigan Recycling WM Invests in Detroit Recycling Facility (MRF)

On October 18th, 2022, WM announced its plans to make a \$35 million capital investment in a new, state-of-the-art materials recovery facility (MRF) in the City of Detroit.

"Our intent with this investment is to position Detroit as a recycling hub for further sustainability progress in the State in Michigan," said WM Great Lakes Area Vice President Aaron Johnson. "We are committed to the environment, the Detroit community, and increasing access to recycling infrastructure."

The new Detroit MRF is expected to create an estimated 50 new careers directly, including administrative, technician, operator, exempt and general labor roles, and hundreds of new careers indirectly.
