Hello neighbors! The recent stretch of dry weather has allowed crews to make substantial progress on several essential landfill projects. The operations team is enhancing the berms and adding final cover in several sections of the landfill to further enhance environmental protection at the site. A new section of perimeter road is also being constructed along Highway 82.

Excavation of the next disposal area is well underway and is expected to be completed by late August. Once excavation is complete, WM will await approval from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), with operations in the new area expected to begin in September.

Additionally, four new horizontal gas wells are being installed to enhance the site's gas collection system. This project is expected to be completed by mid-July. With the new hill online, the system is performing efficiently and gas flow has significantly increased.

While no major events are currently scheduled, a great deal of work is happening behind the scenes to keep the site operating safely, cleanly, and in full environmental compliance.

WM Awards \$10,000 to Support Local Nonprofits
