Skyline Landfill is proud to be part of the Ferris community, and we're committed to keeping that partnership strong. Supporting Our Community Every Day

Each year, Skyline's contractual commitments to the city deliver significant value by supporting critical infrastructure such as roads, water systems, and sewer services that residents depend on daily. Additionally, Skyline provides free trash collection and monthly landfill disposal to City of Ferris residents, resulting in annual savings of approximately \$300-\$400 per household. Skyline also provides waste services at no cost for City facilities, Ferris ISD, and Original Town Square businesses, generating savings that benefit the entire community.

Skyline takes great pride in driving economic growth throughout Ferris by creating over 150 jobs across Dallas Hauling, Skyline Landfill, and the Skyline Renewable Natural Gas Facility. These roles provide stability for local families while helping build a foundation for lasting community prosperity. Our operations generate millions of dollars in annual economic activity, making Skyline a key contributor to Ferris's continued growth and financial stability. Skyline remains committed to creating opportunities that strengthen the local workforce and support the city's long-term success.

Guidelines:

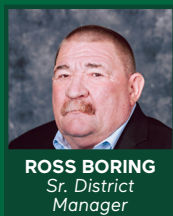
- Items must be under 4 feet and 75 pounds
