Manager's Report

Hello neighbors, I hope you're all enjoying your summer and finding ways to stay cool! I'd like to take a moment to share a few updates from the Williamson County Landfill and highlight some recent community activities.

We are currently wrapping up two key operational projects: construction of a new landfill cell and the capping of an existing one, both scheduled for completion by July. These efforts are to ensure the landfill continues to operate safely and efficiently for years to come.

In the spirit of Earth Day, WM was proud to sponsor the Hutto Chamber of Commerce monthly luncheon held on April 9 at the East Williamson County Higher Education Center. Our team enjoyed connecting with local leaders and residents. We handed out Earth Day-themed giveaways, raffled off reusable travel mugs, and shared information about upcoming sustainability initiatives.

Additionally, WM recently partnered with Williamson County to host a Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) collection in Hutto, TX, which brought in 351 vehicles. This event provided residents with a safe, convenient way to dispose of hazardous items like paints, pesticides, cleaners, and other materials that don't belong in the regular trash. Events like this reflect WM's commitment to environmental stewardship and serving the community, and we're proud to support responsible disposal efforts across the region.

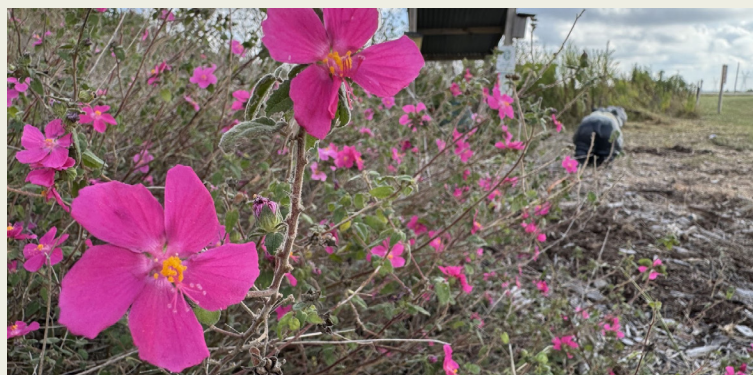
Looking ahead, we're in the early stages of planning our next HHW event, which will take place this fall. While the date is still to be determined, we'll be sure to share more details as they become available.
