Revised Part 373 Permit Renewal Application

Dear Mr. Denk:

As required by 6NYCRR 373-1.8(b), CWM Chemical Services, LLC (CWM) submitted a renewal application for the Model City Facility on February 1, 2010, at least 180 days prior to the expiration date of the current 6NYCRR Part 373 Permit #9-2934-00022/00097. In a letter dated March 30, 2011, the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) issued a Technical Notice of Incomplete Application (TNOIA). The TNOIA indicated that an updated cost estimate is required to be part of the renewal application. On July 7, 2011, CWM submitted a revised Permit Renewal Application, which included Closure, Post-Closure, and Corrective Measures cost estimates.

Based on subsequent meetings and teleconferences between CWM and the NYSDEC, CWM's July 7, 2011 cost estimates were revised and submitted on January 24, 2012. Subsequently, CWM received comments from the NYSDEC via email on May 11, 2012 and has prepared revised cost estimates based on these comments.

Additionally, on May 15, 2012 CWM submitted a permit modification request/revised permit renewal application to add tanks T-8010 and T-8009 as part of Corrective Measures systems known as Process Area III (PA III) and Process Area IV (PA IV). Closure Cost estimates for closure of these tank systems to be installed for PA III and PA IV have been prepared and are provided as Assemblies 5.31 and 5.30, respectively. The cost estimate for Corrective Measures has also been revised to include the operation of the Corrective Measures systems and PA III and PA IV.

Please note that since the initial preparation of the cost estimates in early 2011 using the previously established unit rates, the US Department of Commerce has published an updated Implicit Price Deflators for Gross Domestic Product for the year 2011. The attached cost estimate has been prepared using the previously established unit rates and adjusted by dividing the latest published annual deflator (2011) by the deflator for the previous year (2010), and multiplying the resultant inflation factor by the total amount.

Please find attached responses to NYSDEC comments and the revised detailed cost estimates based on the comments and the inflation adjustment. A summary of the revised cost estimates is attached
