What Goes in the Organics Container:



Food Waste



Meat, Fish & Poultry



Produce



Bread, Pasta, Rice, Grains, Coffee Grounds And Food Soiled Paper



Dairy



- Do Not Include:**
- No Compostable Serveware
Plates, Forks, Knives, Spoons, Etc.
 - No Recyclables
 - No Foam Cups & Containers
 - No Hazardous Waste or Batteries
 - No Fats, Oils, or Greases

Place food scraps directly into your cart or in a paper bag before adding them to the organics cart.

What Goes in the Recycling Container:



Plastic Bottles & Containers



Food & Beverage Cans



Glass Bottles & Containers



Flattened Cardboard & Paperboard



Paper



- Do Not Include:**
- No Food or Liquids
 - No Foam Cups & Containers
 - No Loose Plastic Bags, Recyclables in Plastic Bags, or Film
 - No Yard Waste
 - No Clothing, Furniture or Carpet
 - No Hazardous Waste or Batteries
 - No Electronics

Place recyclables directly into your recycling cart.
Don't bag your recyclables.

Foam Cups & Containers



Garden Hose



Broken Ceramic Dishes & Pots



Loose Plastic Bags and Film



Clothing & Textiles



Candy, Snack & Food Wrappers



Diapers



Pet Waste



- Do Not Include:**
- No Organics
 - No Recyclables
 - No Hazardous Waste or Batteries
 - No Electronics
 - No Tires or Paint
 - No Flammable Material
