Supporting Albany's Recycling Efforts

To slow the impacts of climate change, State law SB 1383 requires everyone (including businesses) to sort recycling and green waste correctly. WM and Albany will begin a container monitoring program to ensure all residents and businesses sort correctly and do not over fill their container. More details will be mailed separately.

Sorting right can be simple, just follow these basic rules:

NO Food or Liquids



Glass Bottles & Containers



Food & Beverage Cans



NO Plastic Bags, Keep Recyclables Loose



Only Compost





Food Scraps



Food-Soiled Paper



Yard Waste

Keep All Green Waste Out of the Trash



NO Opaque or Loose Plastic Bags in Compost
