WM is proud to help keep the Calabasas community clean and green by offering commercial recycling and organics recycling at your business. These programs will help minimize your trash disposal needs, reduce costs and protect the environment.



Recycling Collection

In accordance with Assembly Bill 341, California's Mandatory Commercial Recycling law, businesses that generate at least 4 cubic yards of solid waste, or multifamily properties with five or more units, must participate in a recycling program by subscribing to recycling services

or self-hauling recyclables to an approved facility.

To assist businesses and multifamily properties in complying with AB 341, WM is proud to offer commercial recycling services for Calabasas businesses and multifamily complexes at a reduced rate. Containers are available in a variety of sizes, including 1.5, 3, 4 and 6 cubic yard dumpsters. Roll-off containers and compactor service are also available. To get started, contact Customer Service to schedule a site visit with a Recycling Coordinator.

Trash Collection

Regardless of the size of your business or multifamily property, we can create a customized collection program that meets your needs and protects the environment. Trash containers are available in a variety of sizes, including 1.5, 3, 4 and 6 cubic yard dumpsters. Roll-off containers and compactor service are also available.

Bin & Cart Service Reminders

All containers should be placed in locations that allow easy access and convenient use by customers and are safely accessible to the hauler. Containers should be placed on a paved or hard and level surface whenever possible.

Electronic or Hazardous Waste

Fluorescent tubes and bulbs, electronics (computers, cell phones, TVs etc.), rechargeable batteries and hazardous products (cleaners, solvents, etc.) do not go in the recycling or trash containers.

Organic Waste Collection

Do you generate food waste at your business?

We want to hear from you!

California State law, Senate Bill 1383 requires all businesses to recycle organic waste, which includes food waste and green waste. This new law is part of a statewide effort to reduce greenhouse gas emissions. The goal of SB 1383 is to reduce organic waste disposal by 75% by 2025.

Effective January 1, 2022, all California businesses, multifamily complexes and residences will be required to separate organics waste from trash and subscribe to an organics collection program per State law SB 1383. Organics consists of food waste, compostable food-soiled paper, and green or yard waste. Diverting organics waste and yard trimmings from our landfills will further reduce greenhouse gas emissions and slow climate change. Working together, WM can help your business.

Benefits of an organics program:

- Reduce waste entering the landfills to lower methane emissions
- Preserve and protect the environment
- Reduce monthly disposal costs
- Help the City of Calabasas and Los Angeles County meet state mandated diversion goals

To help reduce waste, properly prepare your organic waste by placing your food scraps in a plastic or paper bag before placing them in your organics cart.

Holiday Schedule

Waste collection does not occur on the following holidays:

New Year's Day | Memorial Day | Independence Day | Labor Day
Thanksgiving Day | Christmas Day

When a holiday falls on a weekday, your collection will be delayed by one day for the remainder of the week. If a holiday falls on Saturday or Sunday, there will be no delay in service.

What Goes in the Organics Container:



Food Waste



Yard Waste



Produce



Food Soiled Paper,
Coffee Filters & Tea Bags



Meat, Fish & Poultry



Dairy



Bread, Pasta, Rice,
Grains, Coffee Grounds

Ensure food scraps are placed in a plastic bag or paper bag before placing in your organics container.

- Plastic Bags or Film
- Serveware/Utensils
- Plastic Containers
- Foam Containers
- Hazardous Waste
- Fats, Oils, or Greases
