Pet Waste & Yard Waste Why They Shouldn't Mix

While certain types of animal manure can enrich soil as natural fertilizer, pet waste—especially from dogs and cats—should never be placed in your yard waste cart.

Here's why: just one gram of dog waste can contain millions of harmful bacteria, viruses, and parasites. These disease-causing organisms can survive in soil and water for extended periods, sometimes even years, posing serious health risks to people, pets, and wildlife.

Yard trimmings, such as grass clippings, leaves, and prunings, are a different story. These natural materials break down safely into nutrient-rich compost that enriches soil without health hazards.

What to do instead: Keep pet waste, diapers, and other contaminated items out of your green curbside cart. Always place these items bagged in your trash cart. With your help sorting properly, we can keep our community and environment safe.



Christmas Tree Disposal

From December 26 to January 23, 2026, residents can dispose of their trees curbside or drop them off at the City of Chico Compost Facility at no extra cost.

Curbside:

If your Christmas tree fits inside your green cart with the lid closed, that's the easiest option. If it's too large, cut it into 3-foot sections and place them next to your cart. Remember to remove all decorations.
