Multi-family Recycling Information

Winter 2026



Reminder: Do not place excess trash in recycling or organics carts or bins. This contaminates the recycling and organics streams; repeat instances of contamination may result in surcharges.



Holiday trees are collected throughout the month of January. Trees must be CLEAN (no flocking, decorations or stands) and cut to less than 6' tall. All Property Managers/Owners may set trees curbside, in the centralized trash/recycling area, or may order a free roll-off box. Call WM at (510) 613-8700 to order a free roll-off box for holiday tree-cycling.

Free Battery and CFL Mail Back Program

Free recycling of household light bulbs and household batteries is available through LampTracker and Battery Tracker mailback products. All orders must be placed by the property manager/owner or designated account holder. Visit wmlamptracker.com/emeryville to place an order.



Properties with cart service may also dispose of household batteries curbside. Place a clear, plastic, sealed bag of batteries (all alkaline, small button, rechargeable and cell phone batteries) onto your GRAY curbside recycling cart.



Free Motor Oil Collection for Cart Customers

Cart customers can call WM at (510) 613-8700 to have a free jug for used motor oil delivered. Put used filters in your own sealed plastic bag. Place filled motor oil recycling jug and filter bag curbside, next to the gray recyclables cart. Do not put the jug or bag in the cart.

Bulky Item Pickup and Free Mattress Drop Off

Multi-family properties are eligible for two bulky pickups annually (4x for 500 or more units). Service is dependent on size and location of the property. Property owners/managers must call WM at (510) 613-8700 to schedule a collection.

WM and the City of Emeryville provide options to manage waste generated by your building and offer education services to employees who may be disposing of items that do not belong in curbside containers.

Small Businesses

Small businesses with recycling cart service only (no bins):

- May place household batteries (all alkaline, small button, rechargeable and cell phone batteries) in a clear, sealed plastic bag, and place the bag on top of the GRAY recycling cart.
- If the recycling cart is full, flattened cardboard no larger than 4' x 4' may be placed next to the recycling cart.



Pro Tip: always flatten boxes to save space in your cart, make sure cart lids lie flat when closed.
