CLEAN-UP GUIDELINES

- Please place bulky items on the curb before 6 a.m. on the day of your pick-up
- The total amount of bulky waste is limited to two cubic yards or 16 large trash bags per household
- All loose bulky waste items must be bagged or boxed
- Do not set bulky waste curbside more than 24 hours prior to pick-up

Free On-call Bulky Pickup Appointments

In addition to the clean-up event, all residential account holders are also entitled to one free on-call pickup from WM annually. Call 510-613-8710 to make an appointment.



ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- **Bundled, bagged, or boxed items** (boxes and bags will not be returned)
- **Household appliances**
- **Automobile Tires** (rims removed; up to 4 per household)
- **Furniture & Mattresses**
- **E-Waste such as TV's & computers**
- **Yard waste** (branches and wood must not exceed 4 ft. long or 6 in. in diameter; branches and tree limbs must be bundled; clean, untreated, unpainted wood only)

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

- **Items exceeding 6 feet in length**
- **Items exceeding 75 pounds, except appliances and furniture.**
- **Wet garbage, rocks, dirt or concrete**
- **Hazardous waste or toxic materials**
- **Batteries of any kind or other automobile parts**
