WM is proud to partner with the City of Mission Viejo to offer free shredding events for local residents and business owners! Safely dispose of up to five (5)banker-size boxes of paper records with on-site shredding.

remove all binders, paper clips, plastic sleeves, and metal butterfly clips from your documents. Please note that the following items cannot be accepted: CDs, credit cards, three-ring binders, wire dividers, newspapers, magazines, and spiral notebooks.

For safety reasons, please remain in your vehicle until serviced.

Residential Smart Truck® Program Has Launched

In response to California's Senate Bill 1383 (SB 1383), the WM Smart Truck® program has officially launched in your neighborhood! SB 1383 is a statewide initiative to reduce climate pollution by cutting methane emissions from landfills. Methane is a potent greenhouse gas released when organic waste—like food scraps, yard trimmings, and paper products—breaks down in landfills.

To support this effort, the Smart Truck® program helps monitor recycling and organics containers for contamination. When contamination is found, residents will receive two courtesy notices with helpful tips to improve sorting. After that, contamination fees may apply for repeated issues.

This program is part of a larger effort by the City and WM to meet California's recycling goals and provide education on proper waste sorting. By separating organic waste into your green cart, you're helping improve air quality, fight climate change, and build a cleaner, more sustainable California.

Free Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Event

WM and the City of Mission Viejo are partnering to host a free, drive-thru Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Collection Event exclusively for Mission Viejo residents. This event provides a safe and convenient way to dispose of hazardous materials—anything flammable, corrosive, reactive, or toxic—that should never go in your regular trash.

What Can You Bring?

- Pool chemicals
- Household cleaners (bleach, tile remover, drain cleaner)
- · Garden chemicals
- Paint products and thinners
- Fluorescent light bulbs and tubes

Unacceptable Items Include:

- Sharps (needles)
- Ammunition
- Appliances larger than microwaves
- Asbestos
- Construction materials
- Leaking containers
- Pressurized cylinders

- Electronic items
- Automotive waste (motor oil, brake fluid, car batteries, gasoline, cleaners)
- Fire extinguishers
- Smoke detectors
- Tires
- Trash
- Explosives
- · Liquid mercury
- Radioactive or biomedical waste
- Unidentified materials

Please bring valid identification to confirm your residency and remain in your vehicle during the event. Regrettably, we cannot accept business waste or walk-up participants. Each car may dispose of 125 pounds or 15 gallons of HHW, with individual containers not exceeding 5 gallons.

Free Bulk Item Pickup

If getting rid of junk is part of your New Year's resolutions, we're here to help! Residents of Mission Viejo can request up to three (3) free bulk item pickups each year. Each pickup can include up to five (5) large items, such as furniture or appliances, or up to 20 bags of trash or yard waste (each bag must weigh less than 50 pounds).

This program also covers electronic waste, including TVs, computers, monitors, and DVDs. Pickups must be scheduled 48 hours before your collection day. Visit

Senior Citizen Discount

WM and the City of Mission Viejo are pleased to offer discounted service rates for qualifying senior residential customers.

How to qualify:

- Must be 62 years of age or older (proof required)
- Must own or rent/lease the home
- Must be responsible for paying the waste bill

This program is designed to support our senior residents with affordable and reliable service. If you meet the criteria, we encourage you to apply!

WM observes the following holidays:

If a holiday falls on a weekday, collections for the rest of the week will be pushed back a day. For example, for a Thursday holiday, service would be on Friday, and Friday service would be Saturday. For holidays on Saturday or Sunday, there are no delays.
