New Solid Waste Services: Enhanced Sustainability and Convenience for Moorpark Residents

The City of Moorpark recently entered into a new Solid Waste Handling Services contract with WM, effective January 1, 2025. This updated agreement includes additional services and revised rates designed to better meet the community's needs and comply with changes in state law. These enhancements aim to improve waste collection efficiency, provide more options for recycling and organic waste, and offer residents an expanded program for the convenient disposal of bulky items, among other services. Together, the City and WM are committed to ensuring that residents have access to safe, reliable, and sustainable waste management solutions.

Bulk Item Collection Expanded

Bulk Item Collection now includes single and multi-family homes. Collection is three (3) times per year with up to four (4) items each pickup. Visit home.wm.com/moorpark to schedule your bulk pick up.

Sharps Disposal By Mail

Did you know that it is illegal to dispose of sharps, such as needles, syringes, and lancets, in your trash cart? You can safely dispose of your sharps using WM's sharps mail-back program. Free Landfill and Compost Giveaway Events

- Moorpark residents only.
- Bring a shovel to scoop your free compost, and a container and tarp if transporting compost in an open truck bed.
- You will be required to bag your own compost.

Free Medication Disposal

Dispose of your expired/unused medications free of charge at the Moorpark Police Station's Pharmaceutical Drop Box (610

Spring Road). Please place medications loose in a sealed plastic bag. Open Monday through Friday, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.



Free Electronic Waste Recycling

Residents may drop off Electronic Waste for free during regular business hours at the neighborhood office located at 195 W. Los Angeles Ave. in Simi

Valley. Drop-off hours: Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

(no business or commercial waste accepted).

Free Electronic Waste and Document Shredding

Free electronic waste and secure document shredding events will be held by appointment at the Moorpark Public Services Facility at 627 Fitch Ave in Moorpark on May 17, and September 20 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. For more information, call (805) 517-6294 or visit www.moorparkca.gov/shredding.
