### Bulk Item Collection Expanded

### Sharps Disposal By Mail

Did you know that it is illegal to dispose of sharps, such as needles, syringes, and lancets, in your trash cart? You can safely dispose of your sharps using WM's sharps mail-back program. - Bring a shovel to scoop your free compost, and a container and tarp if transporting compost in an open truck bed.
- You will be required to bag your own compost.
