To help minimize delays, please be prepared and follow these guidelines prior to your visit.

- Residents can bring up to **two (2) loads** per event.
- Prepare to show valid identification of proof of residency to cashier (driver's license with picture ID or utility bill).
- All loads are subject to inspection.
- All contractor and commercial vehicles are subject to applicable rates unless prior arrangements have been made.
- Commercial vehicle and tractor tires subject to standard gate rate fees.
- Maximum five (5) passenger or pickup tires.
- **Non-Acceptable Items:** Electronic Waste and Household Hazardous Waste including batteries, paints, liquids, chemicals, fluorescent light tubes, TV's, computers, etc.

Electronic Waste Recycling

WM G.I. customers from Moorpark, Simi Valley and Westlake Village may drop off Electronic Waste FREE of charge during normal business hours at the neighborhood office located at 195 W. Los Angeles Ave. in Simi Valley Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (no business or commercial waste accepted).
