- Chairs/Couches/Tables
- Box Springs/Mattresses
- Barbecue/Patio Furniture
- Bundled Branches
- Green Waste (do not bag)

Items Not Accepted:

- Tires
- Latex, Oil or Paint
- Empty Drums
- Motor Parts or Motor Oil
- Pool Chemicals
- Commercial or Remodeling Waste
- Transmission/Brake Fluids
- Weed Killers/Herbicides
- Bleach/Tub & Tile Cleaner
- Fertilizers
- Pesticides & Rodent Poisons
- Anti-Freeze
- Solvents/Gasoline
- Engines
- Universal Waste (Batteries, Fluorescent Bulbs)
- Manure

- **Proof of Norco residency is required. Please bring a photo ID.**
- **Participants are required to unload their own items.**
- **Shredding is limited to 5 banker boxes per household.**
- Residents with trailers will be directed to the landfill to unload materials themselves.
- Please note that company vehicles will be turned away.

Right Materials - Right Container - Know Which Container to Use

A Quick Reference to Your Waste and Recycling Containers

What Goes in the Recycling Container:



Plastic Bottles & Containers



Food & Beverage Cans



Glass Bottles & Containers



Paper



Flattened Cardboard & Paperboard

Do Not Include:

Food or Liquids, Plastic Bags or Film, Foam Containers, Clothing, Furniture or Carpet, Batteries, Electronics, Hazardous Waste, Yard Waste



Place recyclables directly into your recycling cart - **Don't bag your recycling materials.**

What Goes in the Organics Container:



Food Waste



Yard Waste



Produce



Dairy



Meat & Processed Meat, Fish & Poultry



Food Soiled Paper, Paper Towels, Napkins, Coffee Filters



Bread, Pasta, Rice, Grains, Coffee Grounds

Do Not Include:

Plastic Bags or Film, Serveware/Utensils, Plastic Containers, Foam Containers, Hazardous Waste, Fats, Oils, or Greases, No Dead Animals



Place organics materials directly into your organics cart - **To reduce odor, put food waste in a paper bag.**

What Goes in the Trash Container:



Foam Cups & Containers



Garden Hose



Broken Ceramic Dishes & Pots



Candy, Snack & Food Wrappers



Plastic Bags & Film



Diapers



Pet Waste



Clothing & Textiles

Do Not Include:

Food Waste, Recyclables, Hazardous Waste, Electronics & CFL Bulbs, Batteries, Tires or Paint or Flammable Material



What Goes in the Manure Container:

- Keep manure clean and dry.
- Keep manure cart lid closed to minimize exposure to weather (rain, etc).

Do Not Include: trash, green waste, food waste, pet waste, rocks or dirt, horse shoes, feed bags or bailing twine, plastic bags, cans, glass bottles, needles or lancets
