



The City of Oceanside's At Your Door Special Collection Program for Seniors and Disabled Citizens

This free collection service is conducted one time per month on a first-come-first-serve basis with a maximum of 15 appointments scheduled each month. **An appointment is required.** If appointments for any given month reaches capacity, qualified residents may schedule collection for the next date available.

Qualified Residents:

Oceanside senior citizens ages 62 years of age or older or are 55 years old living in a senior housing development, and Oceanside disabled citizens with physical limitations who are not able to drive or have a person living in their household that can drive to the Oceanside Permanent Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility (PHHWCF).

Acceptable materials for pick up include:

- Automotive Products (used motor oil, oil filters and batteries)
- Garden Chemicals (pesticides, herbicides, weed killers, etc.)
- Paint Products
- Household Cleaners
- Swimming Pool Chemicals
- Electronics (TV's, computers, monitors and more)
- Household Batteries
- Fluorescent tubes and Compact Fluorescent Lamps (CFL)
- Thermometers and thermostats

We do not accept biological waste, appliances, ammunition, asbestos, any medicines/pharmaceuticals or radioactive materials. Materials must be in a sealed, labeled container in 5 gal or less.

How the program works:

Step 1:

Contact Waste Management's At Your Door Special Collection'sSM toll-free number at (800) 449-7857 or via website www.wmatyourdoor.com to schedule a free at home collection.

Step 2:

Gather your unwanted hazardous and/or universal waste items. Please refer to the acceptable items list.

Step 3:

Place your acceptable items in the collection kit/bag that is mailed to your home. Follow the instruction sheet in your kit.

Step 4:

Set out your collection kit before 7:00am on your scheduled collection date at either your entrance door, in front of the garage or other agreed upon location.

Step 5:

Fill out the survey card contained in your kit and mail it back to us and tell us about your experience.
