From College Blvd., take first left after entering campus. Follow event signs.

City of Oceanside residents may drop off unwanted household items only, including appliances, electronics, mattresses, furniture, scrap metal, and small construction debris such as wood and drywall.

Be prepared to show proof of residency with a driver's license, gas/electric/water or WM bill. Each household is allowed to dispose of up to four (4) items. Shredding is limited to five (5) bankers boxes per household. Boxes will be returned to customer.

NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS – This includes paints, tires, oil and household or industrial chemicals, etc.

NO CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS – This includes concrete, brick, treated wood and roofing material.

NO COMMERCIAL VEHICLES – This includes enclosed U-Haul/rental moving trucks or Business Vehicles.

Goodwill San Diego, a local nonprofit organization, will be onsite to accept the following donations: clothing, shoes, accessories, books, small household items, and both working and non-working electronics. Donations support free employment programs and services, as well as job training. Donations are tax-deductible, and receipts will be available.
