To recognize your dedication to recycling, the City of Rolling Hills Estates and WM will award one outstanding residential or commercial customer each quarter with free services for a year—plus a signed certificate from the Mayor honoring your efforts.

#### Holiday Tree Recycling Made Easy

WM will collect holiday trees at no extra charge during the first two weeks after Christmas Day just place your tree out on your regular collection day. After the two-week period, cut your tree into smaller pieces and place



them inside your green cart with the lid completely closed. If your tree is too large to fit, simply place it next to your carts on your scheduled service day.

#### How to Prepare Your Holiday Tree for Collection

- Trees taller than six (6) feet must be cut in half
- Remove all decorations including tinsel, lights, ornaments and tree stands
- Flocked trees will be collected, but cannot be recycled

#### What Goes in the Organics Container:

**Produce** 



Food Soiled Paper, Coffee Filters & Tea Bags



Do Not Include:

Plastic Bags or Film Serveware/Utensils Plastic Containers, Foam Containers Hazardous Waste Fats, Oils, or Greases







Bread, Pasta, Rice, Grains, Coffee Grounds

Ensure food scraps are placed in a paper bag before placing in your organics cart.

#### What Goes in the Recycling Container:



Plastic Bottles, Cups & Containers



Paper & Paper Cups



Glass Bottles or Containers

Flattened Cardboard & Paperboard
