

WHAT GOES WHERE?

RECYCLING



Recycle only empty/dry bottles, cans, paper and cardboard.



No plastic bags, keep recyclables loose



Keep food and liquid out of recycling

ORGANICS



Place food waste, food-soiled paper, grass clippings, flowers and leaves, wood branches & untreated lumber in your yard waste cart.

No invasive plants such as blackberry vines, scotch bloom or palm leaves.



No trash, plastic, glass, metal, treated wood, hazardous waste, diapers or pet waste.



No rocks, dirt, palm leaves

TRASH



Place food, food-soiled paper and non-recyclable materials in your trash cart



No hazardous waste like batteries, electronics, used oil



No construction materials

Household Hazardous Waste

Residents can bring household hazardous waste (HHW) free of charge to the City of Redding's HHW Facility at 2255 Abernathy Lane, Redding. Open Tuesday - Saturday, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. 530-224-6209 or cityofredding.org and search 'special waste'.

Electronic waste can be taken to the City of Redding HHW Facility. Anderson Landfill accepts televisions, computers, cell phones. Check with Shasta County to see if there are any HHW collection events scheduled in your community: 530-225-5789.

✓ Place carts in front of your house in street with wheels against the curb by 5 a.m.

✓ Set carts 3 feet apart, away from neighbors' cart and any obstructions. (cars & mailboxes)

✓ Do not overfill your carts, lids must close.
