## Free Bulky **Item Pickup**

Residents may request up to two (2) free pick ups per calendar year, with up to four (4) items per collection. Additional bulky requests are available for a fee.

- · Bulky items include: couches, washers, dryers, refrigerators, desks, and electronic waste.
- Items are to be placed curbside and will be collected on your regular collection day.



#### Kitchen Food **Waste Pail**

Organics cart, these pails are available at no additional charge.

#### WM Observes the following holidays

If a holiday falls on a weekday, collections for the rest of the week will be pushed back a day. For example, for a Thursday holiday, service would be on Friday, and Friday service would be Saturday. For holidays on Saturday or Sunday, there are no delays.

#### **Electronic Waste Drop Off**

Electronic waste can be dropped off for free at WM G.I. Office located at 195 West Los Angeles Ave., Simi Valley, CA 93065. Hours: Monday - Friday from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Typical e-waste items include

computers, monitors, TVs, phones, batteries.

Household hazardous waste such as house cleaners, paint, pool and garden chemicals are not accepted.



### Free Landfill Day

Residents may bring up to two (2) loads of unwanted materials on May 18, July 20 and October 19, 2025 from 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. at the

Simi Valley Landfill and Recycling Center. Must bring ID.

#### **Mulch Giveaway**

A free mulch giveaway will be available to residents on October 19, 2025, at the Simi Valley Landfill.

# **Most Common Contaminants**

Keep these common contaminants OUT of your recycling bin.



## No Recyclables In Plastic Bags

Empty recyclables directly into your bin. Take plastic bags back to local retailers where available.



### No Food & Liquids

Compost instead! Otherwise it belongs in the trash.



#### Lithium Ion Batteries

(Not in recycling or trash.)

Batteries can combust under pressure leading to hot-burning fires. Check wmlamptracker.com to explore battery recycling services.



#### **Propane Tanks**

(Not in recycling or trash.) These items contain flammable

gas and pressure and can be a fire or explosion hazard. Contact your local public works department for proper disposal.



# **No Electronics** & Small Appliances

Donate if in good condition, or schedule a bulky item pickup, if available.



# No Textiles, Bedding, **Rugs & Carpet**

Donate these items if they are in good condition. Rugs and carpets can be placed in a Bagster® bag. Visit thebagster.com to learn more.



## No Tanglers, Holiday Lights, Hangers & **Extension Cords**

They wrap around equipment and can shut down an entire facility! They all go in the trash.



## No Paper Towels, Napkins, Plates & **Tissues**

Compost if possible, and remember to recycle the cardboard tube.



# No Polystyrene or Polystyrene Foam

Foam is not accepted in single stream recycling.



## No Tires, Auto Parts & Scrap Metal

(Not in recycling or trash.) Can damage equipment and are safety hazards. Contact your local scrap recyclers or retail tire stores for recycling options.



## No Concrete, Wood & **Construction Debris**

Can damage equipment. Consider ordering a roll off container on wm.com or a Bagster® bag by visiting thebagster.com.



#### **No Yard Waste**

Compost or put in your yard waste cart, if available. Otherwise it belongs in the trash.
