Holiday Tree & Wreath Recycling

Recycle your live holiday tree or wreath from Dec. 26, 2025 through Jan. 9, 2026, at the curb or in your organics cart.

Holiday Tree

Curbside

- Remove all decorations from your tree, including tinsel, lights, ornaments, and tree stands (no metal frames).
- Place your tree at the curb on your collection day.

Organics Cart

- Remove all decorations from your tree, including tinsel, lights, ornaments, and tree stands.
- · Cut the tree into sections.
- Place sections inside your green organics cart (the lids must close completely).

Wreath

 Place your wreath inside your green organics cart (the lid must close completely).

Holiday Reminder: Keep these Items Out of Your Carts

Batteries

Everyday household items such as batteries can inadvertently cause a fire when they come in contact with other materials in a cart or when compacted inside a collection truck. Help prevent trash-related fires this holiday season and keep your community safe by properly disposing of old batteries:



- Tape the ends of your batteries so the poles are not exposed.
- Place the batteries in a zip-top plastic bag.
- Put the bag on top of (not inside) your recycling cart on your collection day.



Holiday Tanglers

String-like items such ribbons, bows, and tinsel are considered "tanglers" and can end up wrapped or tangled in heavy machinery during the recycling process and should not be placed in your recycling

carts. Place these items in your trash cart.

Winter Holiday Schedule

New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

If a holiday falls on a weekday, collections for the rest of the week will be pushed back a day. For example, for a Thursday holiday, service would be on Friday, and Friday service would be Saturday. For holidays on Saturday or Sunday, there are no delays.

Handling Food Waste After Holiday Meals

The holiday season is a time of joy, celebration, and togetherness, often accompanied by abundant feasts and sumptuous meals. However, this festive period can also generate a significant amount of food waste.

To avoid food waste after holiday meals, start with planning. A streamlined approach to shopping involves a list of ingredients that you know you will need. This also will help reduce waste and save money by avoiding impulse purchases.

Organize menus with family and friends. Whether it's a Thanksgiving potluck or pie-making contest, try to parse out tasks so that too much excess isn't purchased.

When preparing meals, it's helpful to start collecting the food waste as you go. For example, when peeling vegetables such a potatoes or carrots, immediately save the scraps in a bowl or whatever designated receptacle you choose.


