COLLECTION SERVICE GUIDELINES

Effective October 1, 2025, the Town of Indian River Shores will transition to once per week collection service for carted Trash, Recycling, and Yard Waste, and up to 4 Bulk Trash items.

Your collection day will be MONDAY for all services.

Helpful Tips to Maximize Your Collection Services

TRASH



- All bagged materials must fit inside your 95-gallon Trash cart with the lid fully closed.
- Items MUST be placed inside your Trash cart; see **BULK TRASH** below for large items.

BULK TRASH

- WM will collect up to 4 Bulk Trash items each week per residential unit.
- Acceptable items include furniture, white goods (appliances such as stove, washer, dryer, fridge, etc.), grills, lawn equipment, furnaces, bicycles, and vehicular tires up to 25" inches diameter that may be on or off the rim. Please note carpet and rugs are excluded from curbside collection.

RECYCLING



- Clean paper and flattened cardboard; metal cans; glass bottles and jars; plastic bottles, jugs, and tubs (lids on).
- Please DO NOT bag recyclables, items must be loose inside your recycling cart.

YARD WASTE



- Yard Waste, such as small branches, grass clippings and trimmings must be placed inside your cart. No small piles on the ground, please. The lid DOES NOT need to be closed.
- Resident-owned containers will not be serviced.
- Please note, the Town of Indian River Shores has identified certain HOAs that will not receive a Yard Waste cart due to landscaping contracts, meaning these communities will not have curbside collection for yard waste.

BULK YARD WASTE

- Items too large to fit inside your yard waste cart will not be collected on your scheduled carted yard waste collection day. The resident or property owner is responsible for removing bulk yard waste piles unable to be placed inside the cart.
- You have the following options for removal:
 - 1. Self-haul to the Indian River County Landfill.
 - 2. Self-haul to any of the five (5) Indian River County Customer Convenience Centers if the item is less than 3 inches in diameter.

- 3. Hire a private contractor.
- **4.** Contact WM at 772-569-1776 to schedule a collection for \$25 per cubic yard.

CART PLACEMENT IS IMPORTANT!

Remember to place your carts at least 3 feet apart and 3 feet away from any obstacles (trees, cars, mailboxes, etc.) to allow the automatic arm to lift and empty the carts.



Have your items curbside no later than 7 a.m. on Monday.

STAY IN THE KNOW!

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

There will be no collection on **New Year's Day**, **Fourth of July**, **Labor Day**, **Thanksgiving**, and **Christmas**. Collection service will be delayed by one day for the remainder of the week. For more information, please visit **www.WMFloridaHoliday.com**
