CURBSIDE YARD DEBRIS RECYCLING PROGRAM



Accepted yard debris: pine needles, pine cones, garden waste, small bushes, small twigs, small branches, wood chip, bark, and lawn trimmings.

Unaccepted yard debris: large branches (over 3' wide or tall), food waste, trash, rocks, dirt, construction waste, recyclables, and pet waste.

WM offers Incline Village and Crystal Bay residents an easy way to dispose of yard waste. From **May 6 to July 19** and **September 30 to November 1**, residents can set yard waste out for curbside collection on their regular pickup days free of charge.

Ninety-six (96) yard debris collection stickers will be mailed to customer billing addresses in mid-April. Customers may purchase additional stickers at our office located at 1076 Tahoe Boulevard, Incline Village, Nevada. Yard waste left curbside outside of program dates is considered trash and should be disposed of accordingly. See reverse side for more information. →

HOW TO SET OUT YARD WASTE

1

Collect vegetative yard waste in heavy-duty bags and securely tie each one. Please ensure that each bag does not exceed 40 pounds.

Attach one Yard Debris Sticker to each bag and place them curbside on your regular service day from May 6 to July 19 and September 30 to November 1, 2024.

You can also drop off loose or bagged yard debris at the Incline Village Transfer Station. Remember to attach a Yard Debris Sticker to your dropoff to avoid additional fees.

LARGE WOOD DEBRIS: North Lake Tahoe Fire Protection District (NLTFPD) offers free chipping for residents with larger wood materials (dead trees, branches, limbs under 6" diameter). Pile size should not exceed 1000 cubic feet or 30'x6'x6'. Visit www.nltpd.net to request chipping service.



AVOID COLLECTION DISRUPTIONS & CHARGES

- Yard debris bags placed curbside without a valid sticker or outside of the program dates will be collected and processed as solid waste. You will be subject to an additional charge per bag and may be liable for fines under IVGID's Ordinance 1.
- Yard debris stickers issued before 2024 or from other municipalities **are not valid** in Incline Village & Crystal Bay.
- Yard debris stickers are mailed to the **billing address**. It is the customer's responsibility to make sure their mailing address and contact information is updated. Replacement stickers will not be issued. Email InclineVillage@wm.com or call **(775) 831-2917** to update your billing address. Additionally, you can manage your waste account and set preferences at wm.com/login.
- Curbside yard debris collection program dates align with Tahoe Regional Planning Agency defensible space recommendations.

SAFETY NOTE:

For the safety of our drivers and staff, untied or overweight bags will not be collected. **If a bag has not been picked up: ensure it's securely tied, and doesn't exceed 40 pounds.** Return the bag (with sticker) under 40 pounds to the curb on the next green waste collection day or take it to the transfer station. All bags of yard debris taken to the transfer station must have a stickers attached for free drop off. Twelve stickers will be required for a standard truck load (3 cubic yards) of loose yard debris. Customers must present their IVGID card, when using the transfer station drop off option.
