## LYON COUNTY NEIGHBORHOOD CLEANUP PROGRAM COMING SOON

Lyon County residents can dispose of up to two bulky items curbside at no additional cost during the weeks of July 14 and October 14, 2024. To ensure proper collection, please follow the steps on the right. Stickers will be sent to billing addresses in a second mailing. Place on sticker on each bulky item to be collected during the program window.

Acceptable items include single chair, couch, washer, dryer, water heater, box spring, mattress or up to four tires. Items that are too large or too heavy will not be collected to ensure the safety of our drivers. WM **will not** collect car parts, hot tubs, electronics, household hazardous waste or construction debris. A charge will apply to handle refrigerators. Please contact customer service to schedule collection before your regular service day. WM representatives are also available if you have questions about Lyon County's first neighborhood cleanup program.



### A QUICK GUIDE TO GET IT RIGHT

1

Call WM, prior to your regular collection day, to schedule pickup during the weeks of July 14 and October 14. You may choose to use both stickers on the same day.

2

Review the list of acceptable items. Only single chair, couch, washer, dryer, water heater, box spring, mattress or up to four commercial tires will be collected.

3

Place sticker on selected item and set it out on your scheduled collection day. Items too heavy or large to lift will not be collected.

Please ensure that all items are dry and clean. Do not bag your recyclables; bring them loose to the facility. Failure to meet these conditions may prevent your recyclables from being processed and manufactured into new goods.
