FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. What if I have extra waste that won't fit into my trash cart?

A. If the lid of your trash cart cannot close, it is considered overfilled, and you will need to use an excess waste option (see excess waste section of brochure) to avoid fees.

Q. What happens if a cart is stolen or damaged?

A. You can order a replacement cart in a couple simple steps on the My WM App or wm.com. You can also call (775) 329-8822.

Q. How do I find information on my collection day?

A. Download the My WM App for Android and iPhone or access your online account at wm.com/login. Trash is collected weekly, and recycling is collected once every 2 weeks.

Q. Do recyclables have to be cleaned prior to placing them in a recycling cart?

A. Yes, but they do not need to be perfectly clean. Plastic containers, cans, and glass bottles should be wiped clear of food debris, and liquids should be dumped out so they do not contaminate paper products in your cart. Paper products or cardboard that have been stained due to food or liquid residue (such as greasy pizza boxes) should not be placed in the recycling.

Q. Does WM accept bagged recyclables?

A. No. Plastic bags and film plastic can damage sorting equipment and create hazards for employees. Plastic bags are the number one contaminate in recycling carts. It is important to empty your recyclables loosely into recycling carts. Bagged recyclables are considered trash, and contamination fees might be applied.


Q. What do I do if my landlord doesn't offer recycling?

A. Residents can drop off recycling at the Eco-Center free of charge. Cardboard drop-off is located at 1100 E. Commercial Row. Mixed recyclables can be deposited in the yellow bins at 1391 E. Commercial Row. Please follow residential recycling guidelines.


FREE YOUR RECYCLABLES

WM provides curbside collection services on all holidays. Check the reverse side for the hours of operation and holiday closures of our local offices, transfer stations, landfill, and eco-center facility.

CART SETUP

How and where you place your carts on pickup day makes a big difference. Improper placement and overages can result in safety issues, property damage, additional fees, or even lead to your cart being skipped over. If you regularly overfill your carts, call customer service at 775-329-8822 to discuss adding a cart. For easy collection, always follow these cart placement instructions:

EXCESS WASTE

Washoe County residents can dispose of one truckload of waste, four times per year at no extra cost at our transfer stations and Lockwood Landfill. Customers must show a recent WM bill or matching ID and be current with payments. Written permission is required for dumps made by tenants or on behalf of others. A form is available on the residential services tab at **washoecounty.wm.com**

HAZARDOUS WASTE

WM accepts household hazardous waste (HHW) for an additional fee. Call 775-329-8822 for details on accepted materials and drop-off locations. HHW items should never be placed in trash or recycling carts. Visit **ktmb.org** to discover additional disposal resources.

WASTE STICKERS

WM mails 25 stickers annually to help you dispose of extra waste. Place stickered 32-gallon bags, boxes, or bundles (not over 3'x3'x3' or 50 pounds) for pickup next to your trash cart. Waste without stickers won't be collected. Call **775-329-8822** to purchase extra stickers.

SPRING & FALL EXTRA WASTE

During the months of May and November, customers may place an additional six bags, boxes or bundles (not to exceed 3'x3'x3' or 50 pounds) outside the container for collection on their service day without using an excess waste sticker.
