FREE MONTHLY DISPOSAL AT LANDFILL FOR RESIDENTS

Requirements to Qualify for Landfill Benefit

The free monthly landfill benefit is available to current WM residential customers residing in Rio Rancho. To utilize the benefit. BOTH of the following TWO documents are required at time of service for our team to verify proof-of-residency and WM customer confirmation.

- 1. Valid photo ID with address* (driver's license, etc.)
- 2. Current Rio Rancho WM bill dated within the last 90 days OR proof of payment for your current WM bill.

*Address on the WM bill must be located within the city limits of Rio Rancho. Both the address or name on the WM bill must match the photo ID. Paper or electronic WM bills accepted and receipts accepted for confirmation.

Things to Know

- Unused monthly disposal benefits do NOT accrue.
- Tires are accepted with a maximum of four tires per load.
- Clean dirt will not count against your monthly free disposal limit.
- Cash or check payments ONLY (for portion of loads over 1,000 pounds).
- Safety Reminder: The landfill may close due to high winds or severe weather. If the weather is poor, please call ahead to (505) 433-6052.

Delinquent Payments

Please remember to pay your bill in a timely fashion. If you reach 90 days past due, your service will be discontinued and your cart(s) will be removed until a satisfactory payment is made. There will be an additional \$50 fee for redelivery upon resuming service.

WISE WASTE TIPS



Keep Recyclables Loose

Never bag-up recyclables. Instead place materials directly into carts. Also keep plastic bags out of recycling.



Bag and Secure Trash

Help reduce litter from falling out when carts are serviced bagging up trash and yard waste especially on windy days.



Place Carts Properly

Place your recycling and trash carts at the curb by 7 a.m. with wheels facing the curb and the lid fully closed.

Safe Disposal Tips

HELP PREVENT TRASH FIRES

Did you know? The most common causes of trash fires are hot coals, ashes, and flammable items, such as batteries and household chemicals. The coals that helped get your campfire or backyard BBQ going, can quickly start a fire in your trash cart, the back of a collection truck or at a waste facility. You can help keep your family, community and collection workers safe and prevent trash fires by properly disposing of coals and household hazardous waste.



Properly Dispose of Hot Coals and Ashes

- Cool your coals hot coals and fresh ashes stay hot for several days. Let them cool for more than 48 hours before disposal.
- Place your hot coals and ashes in a metal container and cover them with water to fully extinguish them.
- Do not put hot coals and ashes in plastic, paper or wood containers.

Hidden Household Hazards

Many everyday household items, such as batteries, disinfectants and cleaners, can cause a fire in your trash cart or in your neighborhood when they come in contact with other materials or get compacted inside a collection truck. To protect your family and community, keep hazardous items out of your cart. Use the **At Your Door Special Collection®** program to safely and conveniently dispose of this type of waste.

At Your Door Special Collection® of household hazardous waste is available at no cost to all Rio Rancho WM residential customers. It's a safe and simple way to dispose of household items that should never be put into WM carts. Simply contact WM to schedule your pick-up. Some of the items WM will collect at your doorstep are listed here. For a complete list and program details visit WMatYourDoor.com.



- Batteries of any kind
- Compressed gas cylinders
- Flammable/combustible liquids
- Garden and pool chemicals
- Disinfectants and chemicals
- Motor oil and oil rags
- Paint and paint-related products
- Vehicle fluids

In 2023, Rio Rancho residents disposed of 40 tons of household waste through the **At Your Door Special Collection**® program and 94% of these materials were recycled. The 1,205 households who participated in this program made a big difference for community safety and environmental health. When it's time to clean out your garage or empty your shed, be sure to schedule a pickup of your unwanted, potentially hazardous and hard-to-recycle items from your front door.
