



Residential Recycling and Disposal Services



SET OUT INSTRUCTIONS

- Roll carts to street curbside before 7:00 a.m. on your collection day. Residential collection occurs Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Register for a My WM account on WM.com to look up your collection day and more!
- Do not overload carts; lids must close. Overage fees may apply to overflowing carts.
- Break down cardboard before placing in recycling cart.
- California law prohibits the disposal of batteries, CFLs, electronic waste, cleaning supplies, paint, etc. in the trash. Visit www.StopWaste.org/HHW for safe, free disposal options.



Collection holidays are Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day. When a holiday falls on a weekday, pickup will be one day later for the rest of that week.

EXTRA SERVICE OPTIONS

You may purchase extra trash service tags to fix to your own 32-gallon trash bag, or a 40-gallon paper bag for extra yard waste by calling WM at (510) 613-8710. Extra yard waste paper bags can also be purchased at your local home improvement store.

SENIOR CITIZEN RATE

A 20% discount on the monthly trash rate is available for residential customers that are sixty-two (62) years or older. Contact WM at (510) 613-8710 or visit AlbanyCA.org/Recycle to obtain an application. Proof of age is required.

BACKYARD COLLECTION

Carts can be collected from backyards for an additional fee, or no fee for qualifying individuals. Call (510) 613-8710 for details.

COMPOST GIVEAWAY

Bagged compost is available for distribution to residential customers annually. Giveaway details can be found at AlbanyCA.org/compostgiveaways.

FREE ON-CALL BULKY ITEM PICKUP

You call, we haul! Call WM at (510) 613-8710 to schedule an individual pickup for items too large for your trash cart once per year at your convenience. A second bulky pickup appointment is available for the first 300 requests per year. Bulky pickups are available every month except January.

HOLIDAY TREE RECYCLING

Trees are collected curbside on your regular collection day during the month of January. Trees must be cut into lengths smaller than 6 feet and be free of flocking, ornaments, tinsel, nails, and stands.

ORGANICS AND RECYCLING LAW

California State law (SB 1383) requires residents and businesses to keep food and other compostable materials out of landfills to reduce emissions that contribute to climate change.

Refer to the sorting guide on the reverse side to help keep recyclables and compostables out of the landfill.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Household hazardous waste (HHW) materials such as paints, pesticides, fertilizers, propane tanks, cleaners, sharps, and electronic wastes require careful disposal by a certified facility and are not allowed in your trash, recycling, or organics carts.

COMPOSTING TIP

Compost shredded paper, confidential mail, and pizza boxes to absorb moisture in your green cart.

ADDITIONAL CURBSIDE SERVICES

Seal household batteries and cell phones in clear plastic bags. CFLs must be placed in VaporLok bags; call WWM to receive a VaporLok bag. Place all bags on top of recycling cart.
