Reducing junk mail gets clutter out of your mailbox, frees up your time, and helps protect the environment. Go to stopjunkmail.org for more information.




CART & BIN SET-OUT REGULATIONS

1. SEPARATE SEPARE

• Separate Food Waste while preparing meals, scraping plates and cleaning the fridge.







- Use the free kitchen pail, a reusable plastic tub or any compostable paper container such as take-out boxes or paper bags.
- Freeze food waste or wrap in newspaper to help prevent leaks and odors.
- Include food-soiled paper such as coffee cups and filters, paper plates, napkins, paper towels, waxed/parchment paper, and takeout containers.





3. DISPOSE DESECHE

• Empty into green organics cart.

Composting your food waste diverts organic materials from the landfill, helps fight climate change, and creates a valuable soil amendment for farms and gardens.
