





















Holiday Recycling Tips



Here are some common items we encounter during the holidays – and throughout the year:
Where does it go? Recycling, Compost/Organics, Trash/Landfill or Special Handling?

 Ribbons and Bows	<p>Reuse is best but Trash/Landfill if you must.</p>  Christmas Tree <p>Boy Scouts of America, San Ramon Annual Fundraiser - Tree Pickup Day is Saturday, January 6, 2018. For a \$10 donation, local Boy Scouts will pick up your tree. Visit www.sanramonscouts.org, e-mail Trees@sanramonscouts.org.</p> <p>Waste Management Yard Trimmings/Green Waste Cart- Cut tree into lengths that will easily fit into cart and allow lid to completely close. Place tree pieces into cart any time after holidays.</p> <p>Special One - Time Tree Pickup - Week of January 8, 2018 - Set out tree at curb for pickup by a special truck. Cut larger trees into lengths of 6 feet or less. Clean trees only. <i>*Residents in multi-family buildings, please contact your property manager for disposal instructions.</i></p>
 Broken Ornament	 Cardboard Box & Bubble Wrap/Peanuts <p>Recycle cardboard boxes (always flatten to fit in cart) and Reuse bubble wrap, take to packaging store for reuse or Trash/Landfill if you must.</p>
 String of Lights	 Polystyrene Foam <p>Trash/Landfill.</p>
 Poinsettia	<p>Potted plants, cut flowers and wreaths can be Composted without their pots, florist foam or wire frames.</p>  Loose Plastic Bags <p>Reuse is best but Trash/Landfill if you must.</p>
 Pie Tin	 Broken Dish or Glass <p>Recycle after wiping clean. Put paper towel in Compost/Organics.</p> <p>Trash/Landfill</p>
 Champagne Cork	 Holiday Card & Envelope <p>Compost/Organics if real cork. Plastic corks are Trash/Landfill.</p> <p>Recycle all envelopes and paper-only cards (no glitter, foil or photos).</p>
 Drumstick	 Gift Cards <p>Compost/Organics along with food scraps from meal prep and clean up.</p> <p>Trash/Landfill. Plastic gift and credit cards are not recycled.</p>
 Gift Box & Bag	 Batteries <p>Reuse is best but Recycle if beyond reuse.</p> <p>Do not place inside Trash/Landfill or Recycling containers. Seal batteries in a clear plastic bag and place on top of recycling cart.</p>
 Wrapping Paper	 Electronics & HHW <p>Foil and cellophane wrap are Trash/Landfill. Paper wrap (no glitter) can be Recycled.</p> <p>Do not place in Trash/Landfill or recycling containers. On-call collection of electronics, chemicals, paint, fluorescent lights, batteries, & needles from your doorstep at no additional charge.
