Moreno Valley Students Applauded for Inspiring Recycling Participation through Art

Moreno Valley City Council and Waste Management congratulate winners of America Recycles Day Calendar Art Contest

MORENO VALLEY, Calif. - March 17, 2015 — Moreno Valley City Council and Waste Management recently recognized twelve local students for winning a recycling-themed calendar art contest.

Sponsored by a Keep America Beautiful and Waste Management Think Green Grant®, the contest challenged seventh grade students from the Moreno Valley and Val Verde School Districts to depict the theme "Give your trash another life—recycle often and recycle right!" and incorporate small acts that increase the number of recyclables put to reuse.
