Eastvale Residents Increase Recycling through Rewards Program from Waste Management and Recyclebank

Earning points for recycling is easy; residents just need to sign up for a free account at www.Recyclebank.com/WM or by calling 888-727-2978. Once registered, residents earn points based on the amount of recycling material collected in the community. Residents get bonus points once a week if they report their recycling efforts on the Recyclebank website or the Recyclebank smartphone app on their iPhone and Android devices.
