I Love A Clean San Diego Receives \$10,000 Grant Award as part of Nationwide Competition to “Think Green”

(SAN DIEGO) September 2009 – **I Love A Clean San Diego** announces that it has received a \$10,000 cash grant from national nonprofit Keep America Beautiful, Inc. (KAB) as part of a nationwide effort sponsored by Waste Management that encourages local solutions to improving community environments.

In the competition, more than 575 local affiliates of Keep America Beautiful were challenged to present proposals for ambitious projects representing a wide array of stewardship, community outreach and educational projects. I Love A Clean San Diego is one of 15 winners nationwide, chosen from a field of 42 entries in the 2009 program.

“We are very grateful to Waste Management and Keep America Beautiful for their generous support of this project,” said I Love A Clean San Diego Executive Director Pauline Martinson. “Our goal with this project is to encourage environmentally responsible behavior through peer participation and adult role modeling.”

The winning proposal includes a San Diego county-wide essay contest encouraging 4th-6th grade students to think about recycling as a tool for bettering the environment. The essay prompt will ask students, “How would you encourage others to recycle and ‘Think Green?’” The top three essays will win a recycling makeover for their school, which will include an interactive school-wide assembly about pollution, waste reduction and recycling; training for school staff on how to start a recycling program; and all the recycling bin supplies necessary to sustain a program at their school.

“I Love A Clean San Diego should be proud, as our national organization is proud, for their initiative in developing this winning proposal,” said KAB President and CEO Matthew M. McKenna. “Their work at the grassroots level exemplifies the mission of our national organization by engaging individuals to take greater responsibility for improving their community environments. We look forward to seeing this project come to fruition through the generosity of Waste Management’s grant.”

“The Think Green grants provide us with a great avenue to demonstrate how Waste Management and Keep America Beautiful think green every day,” said Barry Caldwell, senior vice president of public affairs and communications and chairman of the KAB board. “After all, supporting communities - making them cleaner safer and helping improve their quality of life - is what our company – and KAB – is all about.
