### **BATTERY RECYCLING UPDATE**

### Correction to Previous Instructions



In our last newsletter, we mistakenly instructed customers to secure used batteries in a sealable plastic bag and place on top of the recycling cart for proper disposal.

Instead, please take batteries to the Butte Regional Hazardous Waste Facility at 1101 Marauder Street in Chico. The facility is open every Friday from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and every Saturday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

If you're making a trip to the facility, don't forget you can also dispose of other household hazardous waste such as paints, pesiticides, fertilizers, automotive liquids, pool chemicals, fluorescent light bulbs, pharmaceuticals, medical sharps and electronic waste.

Disposal of all items listed above are free.
