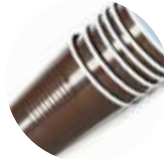
RECYCLE



Recycle paper bags, non-foil wrapping paper, tissue paper, cardboard, glass bottles, hard plastic bottles, tubs, jugs and aluminum cans. Make sure all recyclable materials are empty, clean and dry.



TRASH ONLY



Place foil wrapping paper, ribbons, broken ornaments, foam, plastic air bag packaging, plastic utensils and cups in the trash cart. Consider reusing wraps and ribbons before discarding them.

Important Note: Broken holiday lights, batteries and other electronic devices must be disposed at a household hazardous waste (HHW) disposal site. Visit buttecounty.net/928/Household-Hazardous-Waste for additional information.

Christmas Tree Disposal

Residents can dispose of Christmas trees at curbside for collection from December 26 to January 22. Trees must be free of decorations and flocking, before disposal. Cut and place small sections in the green cart, making sure the lid can close. Customers also have the alternative to discard Christmas trees at Chico's compost facility at no additional cost.
