

SERVICES & INFORMATION

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)

Residents can dispose of HHW items at no additional cost every Thursday, Friday, and Saturday between 7:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. at the Yolo County Landfill, located at 44090 County Road 28H, Woodland, CA. Free HHW pickups are available for senior (65+) and disabled Yolo County residents. Visit yolocounty.org/landfill or call 530-666-8856 for more information.

ANNUAL BULKY VOUCHER

Each year, WM mails one bulky waste voucher to every single-family home in Woodland. This voucher allows residents to haul one load of bulky items and general waste to the Yolo County Landfill at no cost. Please ensure all loads are properly tarped.

ASSISTED SIDE YARD SERVICE

Assisted Side Yard Service is available to qualifying disabled individuals who need help moving carts from the side yard to the street and back. Qualified residents must reapply annually. The Assisted Side Yard Service Application is available at woodlandrecycles.com.

GREEN WASTE PILE & STREET SWEEPING

From November through January, WM provides weekly street pile collection and street sweeping. Outside this period, street pile collection is offered monthly. Piles may not be placed in the street more than one week in advance, so always use your organics cart first! Access your collection calendar and sign up for service reminders at envirowoodland.org/wastewizard.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

WM does not operate on the Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas, or New Year's Day. Service days that fall on or after a holiday will be delayed by one day the rest of that week.

State Law Mandates Composting and Recycling

When food scraps, food-soiled paper, and yard waste break down in a landfill, they produce methane, a potent greenhouse gas that contributes to climate change.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What if I'm unsure which cart my item goes into?

A: Look it up on the Waste Wizard by visiting envirowoodland.org/wastewizard. Search for items not listed here to find out how to dispose of them responsibly. The site also offers printable Recycling and Organics flyers you can post on your fridge or bins.

Q: How clean do my recyclables need to be before putting them in my bin?

A: Recyclables should be clean and free of food. Wet or food-soiled items can contaminate other materials, making them non-recyclable. Scrape or wipe containers with a napkin (which can be composted!) to remove food. If you rinse recyclables, use minimal water and skip the soap!

Q: Can I put bagged recycling in my cart?

A: Please do not place plastic bags, film, or flimsy plastics in recycling carts. They cause clogs in sorting equipment, leading to delays and potential damage. Keep recyclables loose.

Q: Can I bag food waste before putting it in the organics cart?

A: Yes, but only with BPI Certified compostable bags or paper bags. Plastic trash bags or grocery bags are not acceptable.

Q: What happens if I use my recycling and organics carts as a trash cart?

A: Trash in these carts can contaminate the entire load, sending it to the landfill instead of being recycled or composted. You may be billed for additional trash collection and other penalties.

Q: How do I report missed services, broken or missing carts, or ask billing questions?

A: Contact WM at (530) 662-8748 or use the virtual chat feature available through your account on wm.com.

Q: Should I set out my carts if they're not full?

A: Yes, set out your carts weekly by 6 am on your service day, even if they're not full. This prevents odors, pests, and overfilling. Bring carts back inside within 24 hours after service.

Q: How do I clean my cart?

A: Rinse your cart and drain excess water onto grass or landscaping. Avoid letting rinse water reach storm drains as it contributes to water pollution. If you prefer, WM offers cart cleaning services for an additional cost.
